Note on the Cuban Missile Crisis:

The Saturday evening, one week before my commissioning, I went to the local movie theater with some fellow OC's. About half way through the movie the public address system made an announcement that "will the crew of the USS (some destroyer) please immediately return to your ship". One by one during the next 30 minutes the crew of every Navy ship in port at Newport was recalled. By then the theater was less than half full and only Officer Candidates remained. We all sat there wondering if WWIII had started and if we were getting commissioned just in time to be in it. The next morning our company commander Lt. Meyers came to our barracks and told us that our ships were being sent to blockade Cuba in what became known as the be Cuban Missile Crisis.

October 26, 1962 Commissioned an Ensign in the USNR. The first day of snow in New England and I had orders to the USS Cabildo (LSD-16) home ported in Long Beach, Ca. It turned out the Cabildo had loaded Marines at Camp Pendleton and transited the Panama Canal and was in the Gulf of Mexico due to the Cuban Missile Crisis. I spent several weeks in San Diego waiting for her return and always regretted not experiencing transiting the canal. In 2017 we were able to transit the canal on a Holland America cruise. It was a very interesting experience and a perfect year to do it. We went through the old locks but could see the new locks at the pacific side as we entered.
