I have been using this website for more than 10 years. It is a great place to buy recent books at bargain prices and older hard to find books. You can search with the advanced search by any combination of author, title, signed copy, dust jacket, hard copy, soft copy and quickly find what you want. Most recent books that sold for \$30.00 new and be bought for \$10 or less and appear to have been read once.

A recent example. We visited my sister in Wisconsin after the Louisville reunion and I notice she had a copy of a recipe book about the Berghoff restaurant in Chicago. In 2003 we happened to stay in a hotel near that restaurant and had dinner there every night during that visit. There were several recipes I found interesting but I didn't take time to copy them. When we got home, I regretted not having done so and decided to see if I could find a copy of the book, I went to abebooks.com and I bought two both for about \$5.50 including shipping and gave one to a daughter. So, for less than the today's price for a magazine we each have a wonderful book with all their recipes and a history of the famous restaurant that was in business more than 100 years. Surprisingly, one of the books was also signed by the author!

Note: I have not read The Great Bridge by David McCullough which is on Ken's list. A quick check with abebooks.com prices range from \$5.49 plus \$3.75 shipping plus tax from Texas for a first edition hard copy book in good condition to \$250.00 for a fine condition first printing first edition.
